

**Morrow's death stalls arson trial,
Register Guard, November 22, 2000**

The arson trial of two self-proclaimed anarchists is on hold after the death Monday of one defendant's attorney, Eugene lawyer Ken Morrow. Morrow's client, 21-year-old Jeffrey Michael Luers, and co-defendant Craig Andrew Marshall are accused of setting a time-delayed firebomb under a truck at the Joe Romania Chevrolet dealership on Franklin Boulevard during the early morning of June 16. Lane County Circuit Judge Lyle Velure told jurors Tuesday he will decide this week whether to continue the trial for Marshall or to reschedule it for both men.

The pair face a total of 10 charges from that incident and from an attempted arson at the Tyree Oil Co. in Eugene's Whiteaker neighborhood on May 27. Defense lawyers contend that the evidence, mostly common household items found in a warehouse, does not prove the men were involved. The trial ran two days before Morrow died unexpectedly.
